PCOS through elevating androgens or through end-organ androgen sensitivity can exaggerate a number of skin complaints. Focus on CVD Risk

PCOS is associated with long-term health risks, including glucose intolerance and insulin resistance. This adverse risk profile translates into a 2-4 fold increased lifetime risk of type 2 diabetes and a predicted excess risk of vascular disease based on end-points such as coronary artery calcification and carotid intima media thickness. This session will look at the evidence for an increased vascular risk in PCOS and address the potential for lifestyle and pharmacological approaches to minimise this vascular burden
